Turn left ON: (name of the street)

Turn right ON: (name of the street)

Stop AT: when you reach your destination

Adress, street, name of the building

Ex: stop at the corner of Sherbrook and Dickson street.

Stop **IN FRONT OF** (a building, a park...)

Ex: stop in front of the drugstore.

Go to

Every time there is a motion

Ex: I would like to go TO the bank.

Go faster, run TO the park.

Go **towards:** in the direction of...

Ex: walk towards the Museum and turn on Elm Street.

Go **across:** in the direction of... or the verb To CROSS... the street

Ex: Walk to Sherbrook Street and cross or go across the street

You **enter a place:**

Come into

You **exit a place**:

Come out of
Go out of
Get out of

Go around a building, a lake, a park (you circle the place)

Go through a house, a park (passer à travers)

To end up somewhere: to be arrived at a destination.

Go straight ahead (or go ahead)= continue in front of you

Walk on a street (ex: walk on St-Denis street)

Walk down the street (you go South)

Walk up the street (you go North)

Walk one block, 2 blocks, (un pâté de maisons, 2 pâtés de maisons)

Walk until you see (continue jusqu'à...)

Ex: Walk until you see the Statue of Liberty
